Notes:

- This cozy is designed to fit a standard 2 fl oz size bottle of hand sanitizer. Bottles pictured are Purell brand and Target brand.
- Gauge is 7 sc + 9 rows = 2 inches.
- Pattern is worked in continuous rounds; do not sl st to join at the end of rounds. Mark the beginning of rounds as needed in order to keep track of which round you are working.

Supplies:

- #4 Worsted weight cotton yarn (I used Lily Sugar 'N' Cream) - approximately 17 yards
- US H Hook (5.00 mm)
- Yarn needle for sewing in yarn ends
- 1/2 inch button
- Needle and thread for sewing button
- Optional: any additional supplies to embellish the cozy as you wish such as buttons, felt, appliques, etc.

Hand Sanitizer Cozy

Ch 11. Join with a sl st in the first ch to form a ring.

Round 1: Ch 1, sc in ring 18 times; do not join. (18)

Round 2-12: Sc in each st around; do not join. (18)

After round 12 is complete, ch 1, sk next st, sl st in next st to join; do not fasten off.

Strap

Ch 22, sl st in 6th ch from hook and in each ch across, sl st in same st as join along the top edge of the cozy; fasten off and weave in loose ends.

Finishing

To finish your cozy, sew your button close to the top edge of the cozy, directly opposite the strap. Slip a bottle of hand sanitizer into the cozy and strap it some place convenient.

You can also have a lot of fun embellishing your cozy any way you want. I sewed felt shapes on the cozies below to make monster hand sanitizer cozies for my boys' school bags. Some other embellishment ideas could be flower appliques, vintage buttons, a monogram....anything you can imagine. Be creative and have fun!



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
