

## Notes:

- Solid parts of bag are worked in continuous rounds but the mesh pattern is joined at the end of each round; sl st to join only where the pattern states to do so. Mark the beginning of rounds as needed in order to keep track of which round you are working.
- Gauge is 4 sts per inch.

Supplies:

- \#4 Worsted Weight Cotton Yarn (I used Bernat Handicrafter), approximately 450 yards
- US H Hook
- Stitch Marker
- Yarn needle for sewing in yarn ends


# Summer Squares Beach Tote 

## Bottom of Bag

Round 1: 8 Hdc in magic circle. (8)
Round 2: 2 Hdc in each st around. (16)
Round 3: - Hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st - repeat around. (24)
Round 4: - Hdc in next 2 sts, 2 hdc in next st repeat around. (32)
Round 5: - Hdc in next 3 sts, 2 hdc in next st - repeat around. (40)
Round 6: Hdc in next 4 sts, 2 hdc in next st repeat around. (48)
Round 7: Hdc in next 5 sts, 2 hdc in next st repeat around. (56)
Round 8: Hdc in next 6 sts, 2 hdc in next st repeat around. (64)
Round 9: Hdc in next 7 sts, 2 hdc in next st $\bullet$ repeat around. (72)
Round 10: - Hdc in next 8 sts, 2 hdc in next st $\boldsymbol{r}$ repeat around. (80)
Round 11: • Hdc in next 9 sts, 2 hdc in next st $\bullet$ repeat around. (88)
Round 12: Hdc in next 10 sts, 2 hdc in next st repeat around. (96)
Round 13: Hdc in next 11 sts, 2 hdc in next st repeat around. (104)
Round14: Hdc in next 12 sts, 2 hdc in next st - repeat around. (112)
Round 15: Hdc in next 13 sts, 2 hdc in next st repeat around. (120)
Round 16: Hdc in next 14 sts, 2 hdc in next st $\boldsymbol{r}$ repeat around. (128)
Round 17: Hdc in next 15 sts, 2 hdc in next st repeat around. (136)
Round 18: Hdc in next 16 sts, 2 hdc in next st $\boldsymbol{r}$ repeat around. (144)
Round 19-22: Hdc in each st around. (144)
After Round 22 is complete, sc in next st, sl st in next st.

## Mesh Sides and Top of Bag

Round 23: Ch 4 (count as first tr), tr in next st, ch 4, sk next 4 sts, $\boldsymbol{m}$ tr in next 2 sts, ch 4, sk next 4 sts - repeat around; join with a sl st in 4th ch of initial ch-4.

Round 24: Ch 1, sc in same st and next st, ch 4, sk ch-4 sp, sc in next 2 sts, ch 4, sk $\mathrm{ch}-4 \mathrm{sp}$ - repeat around; join with a sl st in the first sc.

Round 25: Ch 4 (count as first tr), tr in next st, ch 4, sk ch-4 sp, tr in next 2 sts, ch 4, $\mathrm{sk} \mathrm{ch}-4 \mathrm{sp}$ • repeat around; join with a sl st in 4th ch of initial ch-4.

Round 26-41: Repeat rounds 24 and 25 alternately.
Round 42: Ch 2 (do not count as a st), hdc in same st and next, 4 hdc in ch-4 sp, • hdc in next 2 sts, 4 hdc in ch-4 sp - repeat around; do not join. (144)

Round 43-45: Hdc in each st around; do not join. (144) After round 45 is complete, sc in next st, sl st in next st.

## 1st Strap

Row 1: Ch 1, sc in same st and in next 7 sts, ch 1, turn. (8)
Row 2-42: Sc across, ch 1, turn. (8) Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.
Count over 36 sts to the left, sew strap in that stitch and across to the right. Fasten off and weave in end.

## 2nd Strap

Row 1: Count over 29 sts to the left of where you just sewed the first strap. Attach yarn, sc in same st and in next 7 sts, ch 1, turn. (8)
Row 2-42: Sc across, ch 1, turn. (8) Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.
Count over 36 sts to the left, sew strap in that stitch and across to the right. Fasten off and weave in end.
